1. Joshua's special challenges
  - A. The people must consistently hear and obey God's laws – Deuteronomy 31:9-13 (201)
  - B. God warned Moses that the people would rebel – Deuteronomy 31:14-18 (201)
  - C. Joshua was replacing God's greatest prophet, Moses – Deuteronomy 34:9-12 (206)
2. God's instructions to the people – Deuteronomy 31:1-6 (201)
  - A. God will lead you – vs. 3
  - B. God will use His man, Joshua to accomplish His will – vs. 3b-5
  - C. The responsibilities of the people – vs. 6
    - 1) Be strong and courageous
    - 2) Don't be afraid
    - 3) God is with you
3. Moses' instructions to Joshua – Deuteronomy 31:7-8 (201)
  - A. Be strong and courageous – vs. 7
  - B. Do what God instructs you to do – vs. 7
  - C. God is with you – vs. 8
  - D. Don't be afraid – vs. 8
  - E. Don't be discouraged – vs. 8
4. God's instructions to Joshua – Joshua 1:1-9 (207)
  - A. God will provide the victory – vs. 1-4
  - B. Be strong and courageous, you will inherit the land (Trust God) – vs. 6
  - C. Be strong and courageous, obey and meditate on the Word (Know and Obey God's Word) – vs. 7-8
    - 1) Our emphasis is to be continual
    - 2) Our emphasis is to be complete
  - D. Be strong and courageous, God will be with you (Know God's Presence) – vs. 9, 5
5. Keys to victory
  - A. Obey everything God tells you to do
    - 1) We must first know God's Word
    - 2) We must choose to obey God's Word
  - B. Be strong and courageous instead of afraid and discouraged
    - 1) Being strong and courageous
    - 2) Fighting fear and discouragement
      - a. Defeating fear – 2 Timothy 1:7 (1155)
      - b. Defeating discouragement – Romans 15:4-6 (1102)
  - C. Remember that God is with you and will provide the victory
