# Why Does God Care About Money?

1. All our resources belong to God and He has every right to require us to manage our resources wisely
  - A. God does not need our money or our stuff – Psalm 50:10-12 (555)
  - B. All of the earth belongs to God because He made it – Psalm 24:1-2 (539)
  - C. God owns everything and all that we have comes from Him – 1 Chronicles 29:11-14 (420)
  - D. Affluence risks forgetting the origin of all our resources – Deuteronomy 8:10-18 (180)
    - 1) When you are satisfied... - vs. 10
    - 2) Be careful – vs. 11-14
    - 3) God was always there – vs. 15-16
    - 4) Taking credit for what God has done – vs. 17-18
  - E. If you gave someone a large sum of your money to invest, would you care what they did with it?
  - F. What do you think God thinks of how you have used what He has given you?
  
2. How we behave with money and material things is an indicator of our spiritual health
  - A. We cannot serve both God and money – Luke 16:10-13 (1014)
    - 1) Are we trustworthy?
    - 2) We must choose to serve God or money
  - B. The things we treasure indicate the condition of the heart – Matthew 6:19-21 (938)
  - C. The Bible mentions two outward indicators of our heart – Our mouth and our money. (Luke 6:45 (999))
  - D. What do those indicators say about your heart?
  
3. If we manage our money according to Biblical principles we will live a better life
  - A. Love of money leads to all sorts of evil – 1 Timothy 6:6-10 (1154)
    - 1) Godliness and contentment is great gain – vs. 6
    - 2) Wealth increases our temptations – vs. 7-9
    - 3) While money itself is not good or evil, the love of money is evil – vs. 10
  - B. The reality is that we don't have to have a large amount of money to love money

***All people are guilty of sin and are under the penalty of sin – death.***

*“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God”*

*- Romans 3:23*

*“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”*

*- Romans 6:23*

***Jesus Christ died in our place that we might be forgiven.***

*“But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” - Romans 5:8*

***God asks us to believe in Him to receive this free gift***

*“For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.” - John 3:16*
