- **What is AWANA?**

Awana is a Christ-centered program that provides a safe environment for children to learn about a saving relationship with Jesus Christ. AWANA is used by more than 12,000 churches in over 110 countries.

- **What does Awana stand for?**

A.w.a.n.a. is an acronym for **Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed**. This comes from the Bible verse 2 Timothy 2:15. "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth."

- **What is a night of Awana like?**

The evening is divided into three segments: A fun and exciting game time, a handbook time where children work on memory verses with their leader, and a council time which usually consists of music, a Bible story, and awards for their memorization.

- **Is there transportation provided?**

Yes! Hope EFC provides transportation to and from Awana. Please call the church ahead of time if your child(ren) need(s) a ride. (308) 234-HOPE (4673)

- **Is there a cost to attend Awana?**

No. Hope EFC covers all costs of the program so we can offer this program to children at no cost.

- **What are the Awana Suppers?**

The last Wednesday night of each month we serve a free supper for all of our Awana families starting at 6:30 pm at the church. The bus will also run early on these nights.

- **Is Awana ever cancelled for bad weather?**

Yes. If Kearney Public Schools are cancelled due to the weather, we will always cancel Awana as well. Other cancellations will be announced on the Hope EFC facebook page.
